The printed books:

- 1- The Karami House in Ihdén, the shrine of the greats during generations ... It talks about the journey of The prince De Joanville, son of Louis Philips – King of France, to Lebanon and the cedars in 1836, and his accommodation in The Karami House in Ihdén.
- 2- The Maronite Hand in the apostasy of the eastern churches (translation and writing)
- 3- Life of the apostolic transmitter Al Khoury Asqof Youssef Chebiha, Lattakian Maronite, the ideal of the freedom fighters transmitters.
- 4- Life of the man of God, Al Farrar Ildfones Marie Al Marouni, of the Christian schools brothers (translated into Arabic).

It is a serious document written by Al Chammas Al Cheikh Antonios Abi Khattar, The grandfather of the champion of Lebanon Youssef Bek Karam, the father of his mother, known by "Al Ayntourini".

- 10- Mustapha Agha Barbar, the governor of Tripoli and Lattakia, "Lattakia of Arabs".
- 11- The family of the sheikhs Al Chommar.

Also in Regulator of Conditions Newspaper under the title " The relocate of the portrayal of the connoisseur al Samaani from its place in Lebanese Book House to be placed instead of the portrayal of the Viscount Philippe de Tarrazi, under the signature of " Maronite", then in Al Seyassah Newspaper saved for its owner Nayef Sukkar (from Bcharri). And in Al Bashir newspaper, he has "the Maronite case of Monasticism" under the signature of "faithful Maronite" which is first published in Echo of the North and has been copied from by Al Bashir. He also has in Al-Bayrak newspaper "Viscount Philippe De Tarrazi, a wide thrust in the Maronite core ..."
